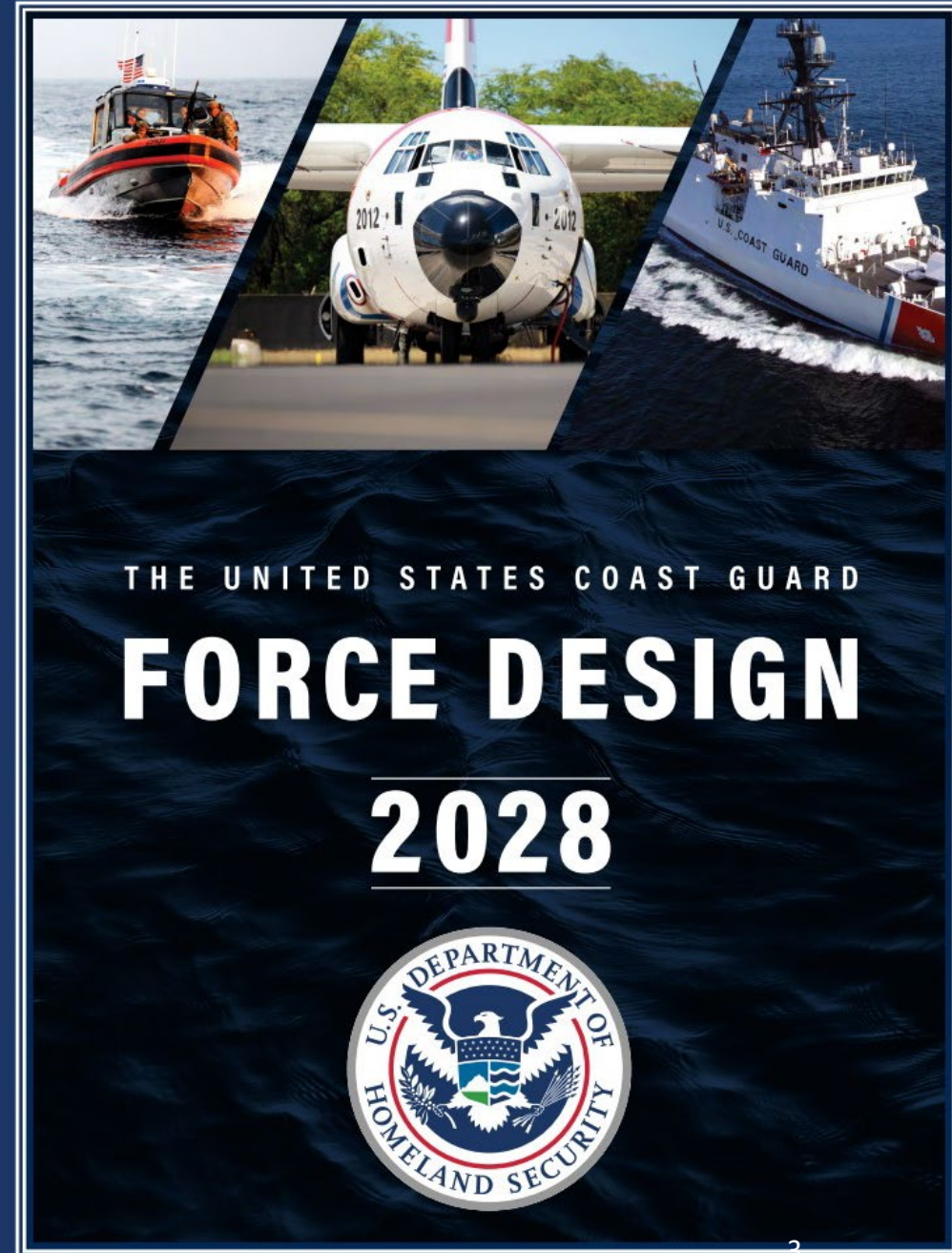

 - Establish a Rapid Response Prototype Team.

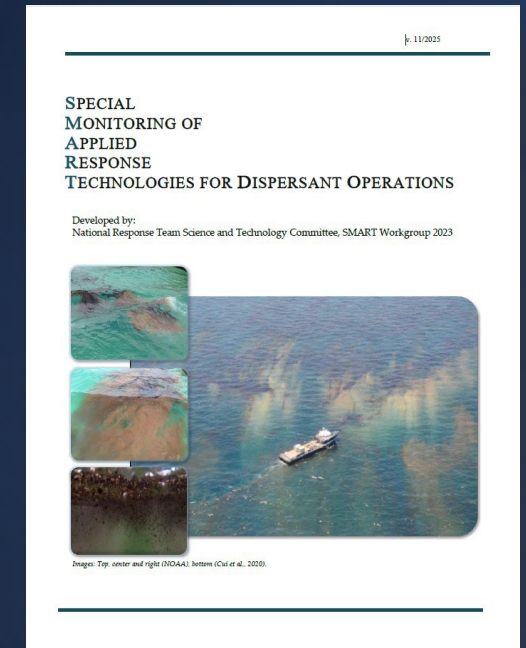
