Subj: PROMULGATION OF THE SECTOR NEW YORK AREA CONTINGENCY PLAN

- 1. This memo promulgates the updates to the Sector New York Area Contingency Plan (ACP). This revision includes the development of Annex Z, Contact List and Common Links.
- 2. The ACP is designed to meet the requirements and intent of the National Oil and Hazardous Substances Pollution Contingency Plan (NCP), is aligned with the National Response Framework (NRF), and is built around the principles of the National Incident Management System (NIMS). This plan is to be used in conjunction with national, regional, and state plans, and provides guidance for a coordinated response by local, state, and federal government agencies, and non-government partners.
- 3. This ACP is electronic, enabling users to rapidly access a wide range of supporting documents that are linked to the ACP. For the ACP to provide maximum support, responders and members of the Area Committee, along with other port partners, must continuously update and revise the ACP with lessons learned through exercises and actual responses. Response personnel should make themselves familiar with this plan.
- 4. At the direction of the Coast Guard's Office of Marine Environmental Response (CG-MER), all Sectors are currently working on updating their ACPs using a new standard plan architecture. Sector New York will promulgate the newly revised ACP once completed.
